

**64-72A Waterloo Street - (Ward 10) - 20/01272/FUL, 20/01273/CON and 20/01274/LBA - Redevelopment of site for residential use (182 units) with ancillary ground floor amenity space, complete demolition in a conservation area and partial demolition, alteration and repair of a listed building - Consideration continued, after division – Declaration of interest.**

2 There were submitted reports by the Executive Director of Neighbourhoods, Regeneration and Sustainability regarding applications by Brickland for planning permission, conservation area consent and listed building consent for the redevelopment of a site for residential use (182 units) with ancillary ground floor amenity space, complete demolition in a conservation area and the alteration and repair of a listed building at 64-72A Waterloo Street (Ward 10) – 20/01272/FUL, 20/01273/CON and 20/01274/LBA.

Councillor Connelly, seconded by Councillor Malik, moved that consideration of the applications be continued for a hearing.

Councillor Andrew, seconded by Councillor Jane Morgan, moved as an amendment that the applications should be considered at this meeting.

On a vote being taken by calling the roll, 6 members voted for the amendment and 7 for the motion, which was accordingly declared to be carried.
