We will put a temporary cabin for bike storage and will run bike lessons, skills sessions and rides from here. we will work with various groups of people who do not have access to bikes or cycling. We will work with volunteers to provide opportunity and training for them. Sunny Cycles is a new organisation but has already worked with many groups since the beginning of the year and has got many people cycling, both children and adults. Although Sunny Cycles is a new organisation is new, our team has over 8years experience in getting people cycling and confident on bikes, people of all ages and abilities. Even in the short time we have been running, Sunny Cycles has built up a community of people, a community of cyclists and those who want to get involved in cycling activities.</p> |                                     |   |

| <p>There are many people who cannot cycle and do not have access to bikes. We have bikes for people to use, and we will help them to become confident on the bike. 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**What are your plans to generate sufficient income/ grants to be able to sustain the ongoing operating costs of the building/ venue/ facility?**

We have applied for and have been successful for some grant funding so far from Paths for All and the Reaching New Scots Fund. Larger organisations such as Scottish Cycling and Glasgow City College have engaged us for paid events. We will aim to have a mixture of grant funding and social enterprise income, and will aim to move away from grant funding where possible. The main running costs will be staff wages and maintaining the fleet of bikes. There will be no utilities on the site. We have funding in place from Start Up grants for the insurance, then would generate income to pay insurance in the following years.

**Tell us about any experience you have in managing a building/ venue/ facility.**

I have over 8 years experience running the Cycling Centre on Glasgow Green. This was made up of cabins and containers. Sunny Cycles will have a cabin on the site, and I am working with the cabin company to ensure we have everything in place that we need.

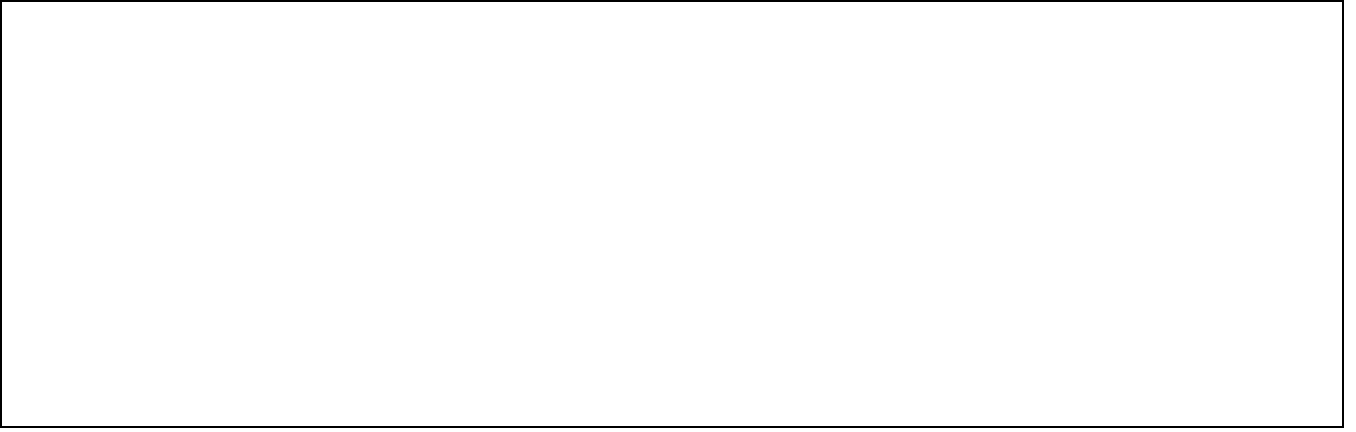
**What help and support from the council family would you require for this proposal?**
