Moving vehicles and cyclists	Injury to volunteers, or to children when playing	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Parents / Guardians to be informed they are still responsible for children's safety • All volunteers/stewards to wear high visibility clothing such as vest or jacket • Road closure points equipped with chapter 8 traffic cones and appropriate signage • door to door letter drop prior to event to warn neighbours in advance of the road closure • Children will be asked to stay off the road until all road closure points are in place and confirmed by a steward / volunteer • A safe system will be created to manage the road space should a vehicle need to pass, including emergency services • A safe system will be created to inform children the road is about to reopen at the end of the event 	
Children going out with the closure area	Live traffic risk	Volunteers / marshals to be stationed at each barrier to make sure children stay within the limits of the Street Play closure

	Risks	Actions to reduce risk	Notes
Members of the public	Risk from activity hazards associated with the Street Play	Stewards to keep watch for passing public and activities to minimise risk and remove any obstructions placed on pavements etc.	
Rubbish in the road closure area	Any rubbish debris on the road / pavement, that may cause children to fall, or may be picked up	A quick litter lift of the road before and after the road opens will be carried out.	
Rain / heat / ice	Risk of injury from poor weather conditions i.e., slips trips falls	The weather will be assessed in the weeks/days leading up to the session and the council informed if Street Play will go ahead or not.
