No access to the GL would be required. Both pitches will be fully enclosed and access managed by our volunteers within the parameters of the sites opening hours.</p>

Will your proposal benefit the local community, a community of interest or both?</p> <p>There are currently no specialist 9aside pitches in Glasgow; meaning we can rent this out to other clubs as well as use it ourselves. The size of this pitch also makes it an idea training pitch for adult sides and an excellent environment to run free football sessions for the local community – at any age group.</p> <p>There are no outdoor 5-aside pitches available in the local area for recreational / casual football – these pitches will be available to the public to book via our app and be open for community use during the site opening hours (ie available to play for free unless booked). We will offer the pitches free to local community groups and</p>		

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allow them to book pitches free of charge (subject to availability). We envisage our use of the 5s pitch to be occasional; no more than one hour per night / Saturday mornings, leaving plenty of free time for community use
